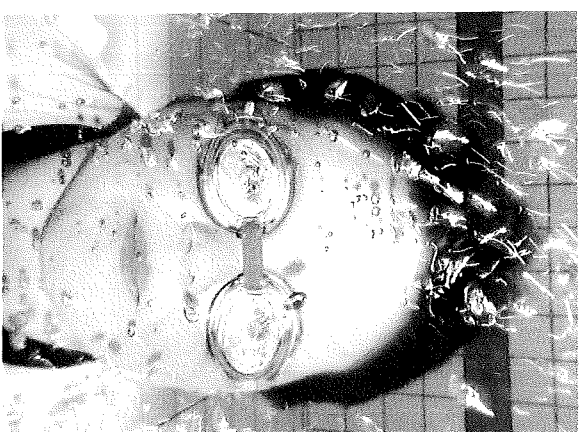
Don't forget we stock a huge range of goggles and caps at reception along with top quality Speedo swimsuits for boys and girls. We also have swim nappies for babies.
